When everyone waits until the deadline to submit, it makes it difficult on the person that compiles The Post. We volunteer our time so please be mindful of that and submit early. Thank you.

FROM THE TREASURER - JOE BOOTH

The year end figures ended up pretty good. We were down in income by \$33,000 and if we had received all of the income projected, we would have been only \$2,000 over budget. Not bad for a 2.2 million dollar operation. Looking ahead through 2012, we are excited to be working with a budget that this Board put together. We enter the year with a good financial position. Our balance sheet, what we have on the books, shows a money market fund of \$153,000 which includes our \$120,000 surplus. We have started to fund the reserves again.

We are experiencing a warm winter so far, so that helps with the gas bill. But we have already encountered unexpected expenses. A water heater went out to the tune of \$9,000 and then the pool heater went out and that was \$3,000. We will continue to do our "balancing act" and try keep things on an even keel. There will always be unexpected situations arising. Our monthly budgeted income from maintenance fees is \$184,251. As of 1/23/12, we have collected all but \$4,600 of that and part of that loss will be offset by other income. As of this date, we have income in excess of our expenses of \$2,300.

It is important for you to know that this Board looks at our operations on a daily basis. I cannot emphasize enough the importance of having a united Board that addresses all of our interests. We are happy to continue to serve Mission Hills for another year. Please review the financial reports on the bulletin board and do not hesitate to speak to me or Vicki, in the office, if you have any questions. Please keep in mind that none of our financial documents or reports can be taken out of the office. They must be reviewed in the office.

FROM THE MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT - MIKE BOGEMAN

We didn't get off to a good start in January. A water heater in Phase 10 went out and had to be replaced. Then a week later, the pool heater quit and had to be replaced.

We are still in the process of trimming trees. We will continue to do so throughout February. When the trimming is going on, please be aware of our work zones. **Orange cones are placed in the roads to mark off where we are working.** This is for your safety and ours. Limbs in the road or falling limbs could cause injury to you or your vehicle. Please stay out of these marked work zones.

In March, we should start roof cleaning and leaf vacuuming. A big **thank you** to all of you who have been raking the lawns and trimming gardens. It really helps out in the long run. Remember, if you need bags you can get them from us.

The painting project has started again. In Phase 4, we are now replacing the rotten wood and by the time this issue of the Post is distributed, the painting should have begun.

Once again, **please do not flush cleaning towels (handi-wipes) down the toilet.** I promise you it will clog the sewer line under your condo or the main line. Then you cause a problem for 6 - 8 of your neighboring condos. Please be aware that if a clog occurs in the sewer line under your condo or in your toilet, it is your responsibility to pay to unclog the line. You may call a plumber of your choice or The Maintenance Department will rod the line for \$50.

FROM THE SECRETARY - VICKI BUCHHEIT

At the last workshop meeting, I commented about the number of non-emergency phone calls, door knocks, etc. to Board members' homes and asked that you put those concerns on the relevant forms in the office for us to address. I sincerely hope that you realize that the statement was not meant to discourage talking directly to Board members. It was meant only to ask your consideration about the time and importance of the call or visit. Most of us are available in the office at various times during each morning. Please, if you want to talk just stop in, or if you prefer, call and ask Denise who is available before you run down.

Just to clear up a question, the audit cannot be finalized until the legal opinion is issued regarding the audit supplements; and that opinion needs input regarding the outcome of some cases already in the legal pipeline. So we will just have to be patient. The overall operations of our community are fine according to the draft we received.

Our documents say that any plantings done in the front or back of our units should be below windowsill height, leaving windows free of obstruction and kept at least one foot from the walls.

There are a number of clubs/committees that have not registered meeting times and places on the office calendar. Please do so. Unlisted events will be preempted by anything already scheduled for that time and area.

Please make sure you submit your proxy for the upcoming annual meeting.

SAFETY PATROL - MIKE PHILBIN

The January Safety Patrol meeting was held so our volunteers could sign up for new patrol schedules and, in general, be a gathering that would be interesting and informative to our members and the Clearwater Police Advisors in attendance. Then the Police turned it into a MAJOR event! Officer Kim Kilian and Mike Spitaleri came with another member of the Clearwater Police Department.....K9 "Major". His working uniform is black fur and weighs only 70 pounds.

"Major", of course, is a German Shepherd...a K9 dog. Officer Spitaleri demonstrated how some of the dog's talents are used. Major follows scents, pursues and disables suspects and protects his fellow officer until ordered to stop...and he's very effective! Major lives with the officer's family and can be playful and almost normal when "off duty", but when Mike dons his uniform and they are in the car, Major is "on duty"!...and only approachable by Officer Spitaleri. A K9's very presence at a police situation can tame violence and prevent further criminal activity immediately. And here's good news...Mission Hills residents have the added protection of having "Major" and other K9 teams spending some late nights patrolling our neighborhood! The teams find Mission Hills, with it's wide areas, well lit carports and limited access, an ideal site for on-going K9 dog training. This activity happens in the middle of the night, when most of us are indoors and asleep...and will never know it's going on. Needless to say, this activity at that time of night absolutely helps crime prevention in Mission Hills...a lot! In the unlikely event you would come upon this dog training in progress, don't interfere. They are working and are here for our benefit. Thanks to Officers Kilian and Spitaleri...and "Major"!
