When everyone waits until the deadline to submit, it makes it difficult on the person that compiles The Post. We volunteer our time so please be mindful of that and submit early. Thank you.

FROM THE TREASURER - JOE BOOTH

Looking at the Operating Statement for the period ending 11-30-11, we see that our income was \$184,661 and our expenses were \$157,805. Year-to-date income was \$1,912,035 and expenses were \$1,658,526. Expenses year-to-date were over budget by \$5,358 due to the new land lease kicking in November 1st and other miscellaneous expenses.

I will be glad to end this year and finish this budget. I will not have the final figures for 2011 until sometime in January and I will then post the 12-31-11 Current and Year To Date Budget Analysis that will give the numbers for the year. We will review these in a workshop.

Beginning January 1st our maintenance fees will increase. The new monthly rates will be: 1 bed/1 bath - \$328.56; 2 bed/2 bath - \$427.87; 2 bed/1 bath - \$398.11 and the 2 bed/1 bath special - \$401.60. Keep in mind that on the average \$69 of your maintenance fee goes to the land lease each month.

I have tried to present a picture each month to you in a narrative form so that it might be easy to understand some of the financial picture. A lot of residents don't know the Operating Statement from the Balance Sheet, and you are not expected to. But it is important that you know in general when things are good and at times when they are not so good. Complete financials are always available for review in the office. During the course of any year, we will have upsides and downsides to the finances. If we can go another four years managing our money without an increase, that would be great. All we can do is try to maintain our property and our reserves. This coming year we plan to try and forecast for additional expenses down the road. In 2012, I will try to address delinquencies from time to time.

I wish everyone a healthy, safe and prosperous New Year!

You've stepped up to the plate by allowing reserve funding to be suspended for the year; by pitching in when trees came down; by weeding, raking, planting; by maintaining the shuffleboard courts; by helping with trash pick-up; and by all the other volunteering you all do. Many, many thanks to each and every one of you. 2012 will see a whole new bunch of challenges, some we anticipate and some have yet to be revealed, but we are already discussing some tentative ideas to meet these new challenges.

Special thanks to our terrific Maintenance Crew! Their efforts provide us with superior service and great savings.

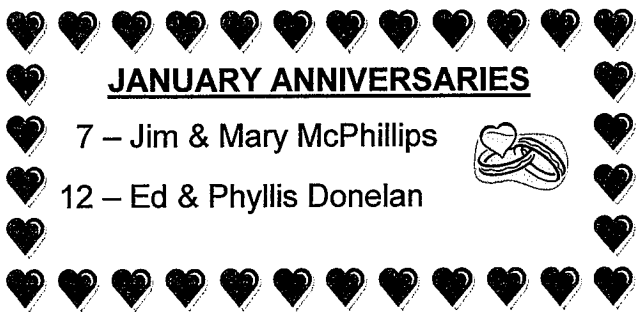
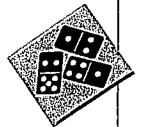
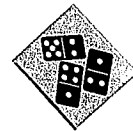
Mission Hills Bible Study Group
