## FINANCE REPORT - JOE BOOTH

Reporting for the period ending June 30. We are over budget for the month by \$4570 due mostly to tree trimming and irrigation repairs. We are over budget by \$ 55,656 year to date again due to unforeseen issues in the community like irrigation repairs, a new AC unit on the clubhouse, and plumbing costs. A lot of this we will not recoup. It is what it is. Just the same our budget is stable considering our overall expenses.

Delinquencies are down and assessments have been paid for the most part for the roofing loan. Those owners who have yet to pay will be addressed by the lawyers.

As I have said in the past....assessments are just part of life, and living in a condominium community. We have been able to keep them down and for this we must be grateful. But the fact remains they will surface and be necessary from time to time. Ameritech has made us aware that other communities they manage have much greater assessments that are payable net 30 days and not paid over time. Please understand that an assessment is always...the court of last resort. We appreciate everyone's understanding regarding this issue. Don't hesitate to question us on this at any time.

## **ATTENTION ALL HOMEOWNERS**

### **NEW AC INSTALLATION PROCEDURE**

Elsewhere in this edition of The Post you will find a new form that **MUST** be completed and returned to the office **before** the installation of a new air conditioning unit can be installed. You will need to complete your personal (name, street address, phone number, HVAC company, HVAC phone number, & scheduled installation date) & return to the office. You will need to instruct your HVAC company to contact the office on the date of installation, prior to arrival on site. We will take it from there. This only takes a minute of your time and will help us to help you make sure the installation is complete.

NEW INSTALL OF HVAC SYSTEM – APPROVAL FORM

HVAC systems installed at the owner's expense must be in accordance with the following specifications, AFTER SUBMITTING THIS FORM AND RECEIPT OF APPROVAL.

- Install of HVAC unit must be installed by a state licensed HVAC company.
- Supply copy of permit before work can proceed.
- Installs are only to be performed during regular business hours. No weekend installs.
- A Brand New Shroud/Doghouse must be installed
- Must be rodent proof. Screening must be installed and no openings around unit for rodent to enter.
- The condensation line (PVC) must be secured to the roof scupper/ roof drain.
- A New Thermostat is recommended for the inside the unit.
- No tools or debris shall be left on the roof after completion of install.
- All packaging and construction debris must be removed from the property by the contractor.



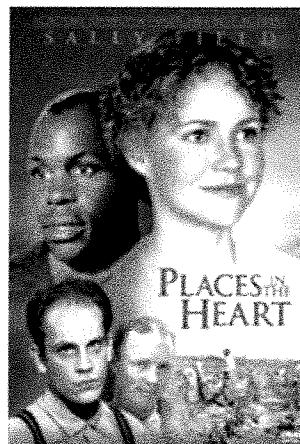

Since you are now armed with that information, this would be a perfect time for you to become a part of something very **positive** for Mission Hills

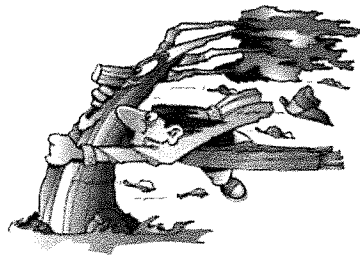
All interested residents are requested to write their name and phone number on a slip of paper, place it in a sealed envelope and label it "Compliance".

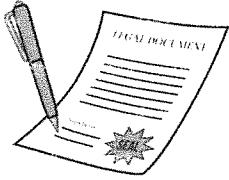

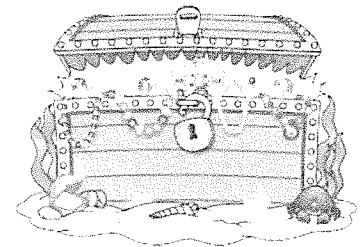

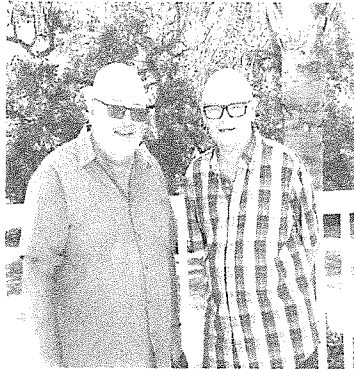


### MEET AND GREET

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
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
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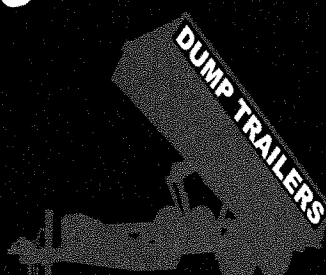
