FINANCE REPORT SUBMITTED BY JOE BOOTH

As this is the first reporting for 2020 for the period ending 1/31/20 we are over budget for income by \$18,000 and under budget for expenses by \$1300 month and year to date.

The financial condition of the community is solid. We leave the new Board with excess surplus and a healthy balance sheet. They can rely on the accounting team at Ameritech to bring them up to speed on the financials. Our reserves are in good shape. Keep in mind that whatever monies we set aside for reserves...we are only allowed to use that money for the intended reserve.

Also the only issues that will negatively affect the budget are unplanned problems or issues that were not budgeted for. It's important that our delinquencies are examined every month and every owner pays their condo fees.

I am sure the new treasurer will be pleased to help anyone that would have questions about our financials. Each Board member should take an interest in the financials each month.

We set a budget but it's not set in stone. Let's wish the Board success in their financial management of our Community for 2020.

The Finance committee will be looking for new members so feel free to contact the office if you have an interest. Whether you are a full or part time resident...your help will be appreciated. We need a strong Finance Committee.

Compliance

Compliance is conforming to a goal that organization need for operation

NOW YOU KNOW

The package of information regarding the complete details regarding COMPLIANCE had been published in the April, 2019 issue of our Mission Hills Post (repeated below).

The functions of a Compliance Committee as it is written in the Florida State Statute 718 were clearly outlined.

Since you are now armed with that information, this would be a perfect time for you to become a part of something very positive for Mission Hills.

All interested residents are requested to write their name and phone number on a slip of paper, place it in a sealed envelope and label it "Compliance", ATTN: Kay Hunt. Drop it in the office mail slot and you will be notified of an interview date and time.

Remember: you are not required to be a full-time resident. You must, however, be an owner.

You have the laws .. now let's form the order!

COMPLIANCE COMMITTEE AND HOW IT FUNCTIONS

Our Management Company, Ameri-tech, tours our community and notes violations of our By-Laws, the Declaration, or the Florida State Statute 718. The results of this initial survey are given directly to the Mission Hills Board of Directors.

So what, then, is the role of the Compliance Committee?

Chapter 718 Florida Statutes (718.303(3)(b)), dated July, 2018, states, in part that "A fine or suspension levied by the board of administration may not be imposed unless the board first provides at least 14 days' written notice to the unit owner and, if applicable, any occupant, licensee, or invitee of the unit owner sought to be fined or suspended, and an opportunity for a hearing before a committee of at least three members appointed by the board who are not officers, directors, or employees of the association, or the spouse, parent, child, brother, or sister of an officer, or employee. The role of the committee is limited to determining whether to confirm or reject the fine or suspension levied by the board. If the committee does not approve the proposed fine or suspension by majority vote, the fine or suspension may not be imposed."

The preceding paragraphs are key to understanding the role of a Compliance Committee. The committee does not search the community for violations, report violations to the board, nor determine what a fine will be. What the committee does do, if requested by the resident(s) is to meet with him, her or them and review the situation and decide whether the fine proposed by the board is fair and reasonable.

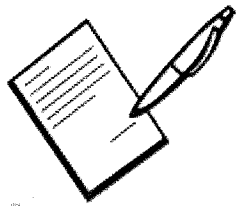
The Mission Hills Color Enhancement Team - 2020

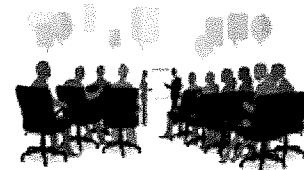

BUFFALO CRACK CHICKEN DIP

This dip is super easy to whip up... and it's soooooo good!!!

- 3 cups shredded rotisserie chicken or about 1lb chicken breasts cooked and shredded
- 1 8oz package cream cheese
- 2 cups mozzarella cheese
- Ranch seasoning mix
- 1 cup cheddar cheese
- 1 cup mayo and sour cream
- 1/2 cup chopped green onions
- 1/2 cup buffalo sauce
- 1 teaspoon garlic, minced
- 1/2 lb bacon cooked and chopped

How to make buffalo crack chicken dip?

1. Lightly spray with cooking spray a 2qt baking dish, set aside.
2. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F.
3. Combine all the ingredients starting with the shredded cooked chicken up to the minced garlic. Stir well to combine. Transfer to the prepared baking dish.
4. Top with the cooked chopped bacon.
5. Bake in the preheated oven for 25-30 minutes, until hot and bubbly.
6. Serve immediately with crackers or toasted cocktail bread

Can I make buffalo crack chicken dip in advance?

Yes, it is very easy to prepare ahead, and then bake before your guests arrive. The dip takes about 15 minutes to assemble together, so it is very convenient. For best results, we recommend preparing the dip one day in advance and store in the refrigerator before baking. When ready to serve, put the prepared dip in the oven at 350 degrees F and cook for about 25-30 minutes.
