ur October income was \$201.426, and our expenses were \$213,596, which is over budget by \$12,270.

As of October 31, 2021 we are under budget year-to-date by \$29,954. This is because of prepaid condo fees and the 2021 assessment.

The balance on the 2021 Special Assessment is \$1,323, and is in the hands of our attorney for collection.



CROCK POT BROWN SUGAR PINEAPPLE HAM

A Facebook Recipe submitted by Helen J. Strupczewski

This is one oh-so-yummy dish perfect for the holidays...and you will even have time to visit with your company!

INGREDIENTS:

1 Ham, pre-cooked, spiral cut/bone-in or boneless
3½ cups Brown Sugar
½ cup Raw Natural Honey
1 20 oz. can Pineapple Tidbits or Chunks, do not drain



INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. In a large crock pot, 6-quarts or larger, cover the bottom with only 2 cups of the brown sugar.
- 2. Place ham on top of the brown sugar and open the slices slightly with your hands.
- 3. Pour the Honey evenly over the ham.
- 4. Add the pineapple around the sides (with the juice) and some on top
- 5. Top with the remaining $1\frac{1}{2}$ cups of brown sugar, making sure it is evenly distributed over the entire top of the ham.
- 6. Cover and cook on low for 3½ to 4 hours.






