As of May 31, 2021, our finances remain stable. Income for May was under budget by \$19,244 and expenses were under budget by \$15,326, which leaves us over budget for May \$3,918.

However, the January – May 2021 figures show that we are under budget by \$56,324, which is due mainly to prepaid fees and the 2021 assessment.



1 8 oz. pkg. Cream Cheese, softened and broken into small pieces

2 cups Cheddar Cheese OR Jalapeno Jack Cheese, grated

1 cup of Mayonnaise

1 sm. Purple Onion, diced (you can use diced green onion or onion powder),

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Place all ingredients into a shallow baking dish (a 9" square pan or pie dish).
- 2. Microwave on high for about 2 minutes or until all ingredients are melted enough to stir together (may have to repeat microwave).
- 3. Keep stirring until thoroughly combined.
- 4. Bake at 350 for 20 minutes or until lightly browned.
- 5. Serve with Wheat Thins or a veggie tray.

LAW OF THE LAND

MISSION HILLS CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION HURRICANE SHUTTER POLICY STATEMENT

To ensure uniformity in the appearance of Mission Hills Condominium units, the Board of Directors has established this policy for hurricane shutters in accordance with Florida State Statue 718.113, Section 5.

If an owner desires to install hurricane shutters on his/her unit, the installation may be done on the outside or the inside of the unit.

If on the outside, the owner must first contact the Mission Hills office. Any owner(s) interested in installing exterior hurricane shutters must obtain descriptions and specifications of shutters that are suitable for use on their specific units.

The purchase, upkeep and maintenance of hurricane shutters shall be the responsibility of the unit owner(s) on which they are installed. ★

The Condominium Living Mindset

he mindset for condominium living is different than any other residential environment. It is the most limited way to live regarding expectations surrounding the outside of your home. That being said, some residents living in Mission Hills still have the single-family home/no deed restrictions mindset, which seems to limit their acceptance of and adherence to the condominium laws and rules that govern condominium living.

We are governed by the State of Florida, Statute 718, and our own by-laws and condominium documents. Anyone who wants a copy of our documents need only go to our public website or the ePortal website at missionhillscondos.org. To get to the ePortal, go to the address shown and click Login to enter your credentials. If you don't have any, click Register and complete the information. Ameri-Tech will provide your password and give you access to this private website. If you wish to view the laws of the statute, you can go to http://www.leg.state.fl.us/Welcome/index.cfm and search for Florida Statute 718, or go directly via this link. I know it's long, but it takes you directly to the beginning of the statute and the table of contents.

All members of the association Board of Directors sign and certify that they will govern, uphold and enforce their association's documents. The goal of your Board is to make things as clear as possible to all residents. There are resources available, and they are listed in the Post. Each resident signed a statement before moving in agreeing to read and abide by our condo documents. There are no exceptions to this legal and binding policy. We are all responsible for our part in keeping this community maintained, keeping the property values protected, being fiscally responsible, and, hopefully, maintain peace.

Our Maintenance Team does their utmost to see that work orders are completed in a timely manner. However, there are a LOT of responsibilities that must be taken care of prior to those work orders. I was astonished at the lengthy report John provided at the May board meeting describing all that his team is responsible for to make this community the best it can be. In that vein, please know that emergencies are taken care of through Ameri-Tech, our property manager. Their number is listed in the directory on page 2 of this newsletter.

I beseech all residents of Mission Hills to come to an understanding of our documents and make a conscious decision to abide by them. It has been said more than once...we are all in this together. ★




