December Over Budget: \$ 29,884 YTD Over Budget: \$ 29,936

The balance on the 2021 Special Assessment is \$1,414 and is being handled by our attorney.

Considering all the unexpected expenses in 2021, being over budget by only \$29,936 is good. Our budget is only a guideline to follow and even though we try to stay within the

budget, it's not always possible. Rest assured that we are financially stable as we enter 2022.







Canned Pineapple Rings or Fresh Pineapple, drained (garnish)




- 1. Combine crushed pineapple and juices, sour cream, and vanilla pudding mix in a large bowl and stir until fully incorporated.
