As stated at the Board meeting we are currently under budget by \$14,097.58 for the month of April.

Over budget year to date: \$65,608.01.

We're working directly with residents with delinquencies to help resolve them. To date four (4) have been resolved. If I have not yet contacted you, either reach out to me, or be patient as I work through the list.

Per discussions with Ameritech:

A couple of the Home Depot invoices from prior months were recoded. That is what caused 6100, Bldg-Supplies/Repairs to show negative.

There was a recode on 4/26 in the amount of \$4225 for an invoice that was originally coded to 6130 but changed to be paid from 2060 so that credited it back to 6130, Roof Repair-Minor.

The negative for 7000, Electric, from March was an entry from December that was voided. When the system voided that one it should have credited prior years not 7000 since the activity was last year, 2022. Ameritech will make a Journal entry to correct that.

On the western part of our property, we repaired  $\sin - 4 \times 8$  sections of fence, helping our neighbor after they cut down three trees in their yard.


When doing after work orders, you do have to pay for the work being done.





# WATER USAGE



# Stamps for the Wounded Project



In working with Ameritech one of the additional things that has come to the Board's attention are the problems caused when payments are made by check without the coupon, or at least the account number. If you do not wish to pay electronically, then please <u>always</u> include the coupon with your check. This will ensure that your payment is properly applied to **your** account.

If you would like to pay electronically and have concerns and/or questions I would be happy to schedule a meeting where we could talk about the options available and how to go about doing this. I'll put a sign up sheet in the Clubhouse lobby. If at least 5 people are interested I'll put together a presentation.

The easiest way to do electronic payment is Association Pay (ACH). You fill out a form for the bank, Truist, and send it in. They use this information to set up an automatic payment from your bank account; you choose which account when you fill out the form. Then each month the money is transferred from your account to the Mission Hills account automatically. You never have to worry about forgetting to make a payment. There is no fee to you for this method of payment and there is no cost to Mission Hills.

The next best way to do this is Online Bill-Pay Service, which is offered by most banks. You go into your online bank account and set up this payment to be sent from your bank to Mission Hills each month. You'll use the account number on your coupon when setting this up. There is usually no fee to you for this method of payment but do check with your bank to be certain. There is no cost to Mission Hills. Please be certain to use a date prior to the due date to avoid a late fee.

If you still want to pay each month by check, you can use eCheck, which is an electronic check. This is a one-time payment so you would still have to do this each month. Go to <a href="mailto:truist.com/payments">truist.com/payments</a> and have your coupon ready so that you can enter the account number, to credit the payment properly when requested on-screen. There is no fee to you for this method of payment and there is no cost to Mission Hills. Payments may take up to four (4) days to process, so please allow enough time not to incur a late fee.

You can also go to a branch of Truist, with your coupon, and make the payment. There is a branch on Sunset Point. It's on the south side of the street immediately after the bike trail. There is another branch at the corner of McMullen Booth and Enterprise in the Publix shopping center which is in the NW corner of the intersection. The branch sits right on McMullen Booth and Enterprise within the shopping center. There is a 3rd branch on Gulf to Bay just west of Belcher, across Gulf to Bay from the WaWa. And the next nearest to us is on 19 at Countryside near Dick's Sporting Goods. Payments will be processed the next business day.

Finally, if you wish to mail a check to Ameritech, please be aware that mail does get lost, and there have been instances of this happening since the first of this year. Be certain to include the coupon and that the account number from your coupon is written on your check in case the coupon and the check become separated. When you mail a check to Ameritech, or drop it off there, Mission Hills will be charged a \$2.00 fee for each check.

# DID YOU KNOW THAT . . .






