Trash and Recycling

Receptacles are usually located in your carport area or on the other side of the 3 pack or breezeway adjacent to your carport.

Trash...

Large green cans are for household trash and garbage, Secure the latch and report broken latches by filling out a work order including the carport location.

Syringes **MUST NOT** ever be placed in the trash. That is hazardous waste and your doctor or the county health department can assist with their disposal.

Recycling...

All recycled materials must be empty, dry and unbagged. Nothing smaller than your hand is to be placed in the bins.

It is not necessary to separate the items.

Allowable items are:

1. Metal (only food and drink cans)
2. Glass (only bottles and jars)
3. Plastic (only bottles and jugs)
4. Paper and cardboard (NO food containers, no shredded papers)
5. Cartons (milk and drink cartons, no straws)

All items must be cleaned. All boxes MUST be broken down and placed next to the bins. It is not the responsibility of maintenance to take and break down boxes. They will be left until they are properly broken down and folded.

Other suggestions:

Plastic shopping bags and Styrofoam are not recyclable. They can be taken to various area stores.

Electronic items can be dropped off at the Clearwater Collection Site located on North Hercules, on the last Wednesday of each month.

Put garbage and recycling out from Monday morning through Friday. Collection takes place Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

It is your responsibility to have all household furnishings and remodeling debris removed from the property, NOT dropped off at the compactor area or in the trash containers. ***THIS INCLUDES BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO WOOD SCRAPS, NAILS, OLD CABINETS, AND FLOORING.***

Small household furnishings may be dropped off at the compactor area during open maintenance hours only.

Any contractors doing any type of work are required to remove all trash and contracting debris on their own to a local facility. They are NOT permitted to use trash containers, compactor, or any dumpster that belongs to Mission Hills.

Do not remove trash bins or recycle bins. They are located where they provide for ease of use for all residents and maintenance access.
