FINANCE REPORT - JOE BOOTH

Reporting for the period ending 2/28/19, we are over budget month to date by \$21,293 and over budget year to date by \$19,691. Not unusual for this time of year when we have a full complement of residents.

We were pleased to see our residents turn out for the meeting re the assessment on the roofs. And we hope you are all understanding that this is necessary for the good of this community. Already, a large number of owners have paid their bill and we are hopeful everyone will pay before the deadline. As outlined in the letter you received dated March 6, 2019 all payments are due by MAY 1, 2019 but not later than MAY 15, 2019. After this date a late payment fee will be imposed as allowed by FI statute 718.116(3).

If you do not pay the assessment along with the late fee by June1, 2019 we will have no choice but to begin legal proceedings to collect the amount due. No exceptions can be made and no payment plans will be available.

If you have any questions at all contact the office. all payments can be made by check or money order. no cash.

Our financial priorities this year will be the roof replacements and the carports. We need to prioritize as we never know what unexpected issues might arise. Already, as an example, we have expended the budgeted monies for water heaters. regardless...we will find it if we need to.

NEIGHORHOOD WATCH-MIKE PHILBIN

I thought it might be a good time to explain what the Mission Hills Neighborhood Watch is, what it does and how it contributes to the quality of life we enjoy here. We're there for you, but you may not notice...and that isn't necessarily bad because we're doing our job!

The "NW" is one of the oldest continuing community services in Mission Hills. The dedicated volunteers, patrol our streets each night using their own cars, checking for burned out lighting, ticketing illegally parked cars (ambulances and fire engines MUST be able to get to our units FAST!) and, especially, discourage criminal trespassing. They do not carry firearms, and report any

suspicious activity or persons to the Clearwater Police. The success of the "NW" activity is measured by it's invisibilty. the lights get fixed, cars don't block our roads and we have very little crime, all done quietly and without fanfare. The residents who make up the Watch are obviously special people who know why this activity helps keep Mission Hills the quiet and safe place it is... and are willing to help keep it that way.

Joining the "NW" is a nice way to perform a community service, and we encourage anyone living here, full time, part time ,rents or owns, to join us.

We will be an important membership meeting on Thursday, April 4 at 7PM in the Clubhouse TV room. And yes, we do need new volunteers, as several of our current members are heading north. Summer means we have more "activity" because of the longer daylight and more school-aged youth "wandering". HELP!

LAW OF THE LAND

COMPLIANCE COMMITTEE AND HOW IT FUNCTIONS

Our Management Company, Ameri-tech, tours our community and notes violations of our By-Laws, Declaration, or the Florida State Statute 718

The results of this initial survey are given directly to the Mission Hills Board of Directors.

So what, then, is the role of the Compliance Committee?

Chapter 718 Florida Statutes (718.303(3)(b), dated July, 2018, states, in part that "A fine or suspension levied by the board of administration may not be imposed unless the board first provides at least 14 days' written notice to the unit owner and, if applicable, any occupant, licensee, or invitee of the unit owner sought to be fined or suspended, and an opportunity for a hearing before a committee of at least three members appointed by the board who are not officers, directors, or employees of the association, or the spouse, parent, child, brother, or sister of an officer, or employee.

The role of the committee is limited to determining whether to confirm or reject the fine or suspension levied by the board. If the committee does not approve the proposed fine or suspension by majority vote, the fine or suspension may not be imposed."

The preceding two sentences are key to understanding the role of a Compliance Committee. The committee does not search the community for violations, report violations to the board, nor determine what a fine will be. What the committee does do, if requested, by the resident(s) is to meet with him, her or them and review the situation and decide whether the fine proposed by the board is fair and reasonable.

Impossible Coconut Pie

45-50 minutes to prepare serves 8

INGREDIENTS

2 cups whole milk
3/4 cup sugar
1/4 cup biscuit mix, we used bisquick
4 large eggs
1/4 cup (1/2 stick) unsalted butter, room temperature



1 teaspoon vanilla extract

1/2 teaspoon coconut extract

1 1/2 tablespoons amber rum

1/4 teaspoon salt

1 cup shredded coconut, plus extra for garnish, optional

PREPARATION

Preheat oven to 350° F and lightly grease a 9-inch pie plate with butter or non-stick spray. Pour milk, sugar, biscuit mix, eggs and butter into blender or food processor. Add vanilla and coconut extracts, then rum, if using. Finally, add in salt and coconut. Cover blender or food processor and pulse for 2-3 minutes, or until everything is puréed and frothy. Pour into greased pie pan and place in oven. Bake for 38-42 minutes or until center is just set.

Remove from oven and let cool 15 minutes before serving.
