FINANCE REPORT - JOE BOOTH

Reporting for the period ending 12/31/18. End of another year. Let's talk bottom line. We are over budget for the year by \$21,000. Considering we have a 2.4 million dollar budget being less than 1% over is pretty good. We strive to come in under budget but this has been a very challenging year for us financially. The overage is due to unexpected costs in managing the community. We had unexpected carport costs not planned for and then significant costs in taking care of damage to a unit that became compromised with mold and the loss of income from that unit. All unavoidable. Regardless, this Board and Ameritech should be lauded for managing our monies and this community in a responsible manner. We have completed the pool with money we started to reserve in 2007. And with the help of our maintenance staff have saved thousands. We put together a budget for 2019 that included an increase in monthly fees but that goes with the cost of living in a condo community. Everyone who invests in a condo association should know and always be prepared for increases and assessments. It's going to happen. The assessments we have experienced here in Mission Hills since 2007 have been minimal compared to what a lot of condo associations assess. The Board should always do their best to minimize this when it happens. Proper reserve planning is vital. Between the reserves and our other cash lines we still remain very strong financially. We were able to pay off our roof loan about 2 years earlier than expected. As always Vicki or I will be pleased to meet with anyone who would like to review our finances and how we manage them. You have a very responsible Board and we try to stay on top of problems. We are looking at those unit owners that have not paid their water pipe assessment. They are now in the hands of the attorney. Also, anyone in arrears on their monthly fees will be turned over to the attorney. We ask you to be responsible and pay on time to avoid additional costs and legal fees.

We had our first sign-up meeting in January and I'm pleased to report your Neighborhood Watch is alive and well. We are fortunate to have newer people step forward and support our NW activity. Thank you.

1/2 cup pizza sauce 1 1/2 cups shredded mozzarella cheese optional toppings - pepperoni, ham, sausage, mushrooms, peppers Garlic powder (to taste)



Preheat oven to 350.

Lightly spay a 9×13 baking dish with cooking spray. With a handheld mixer, mix cream cheese, eggs, pepper, garlic powder and parmesan cheese until combined. Spread into baking dish. Bake for 12-15 minutes, or until golden brown. Allow crust to cool for 10 minutes.

Spread pizza sauce on crust. Top with cheese and toppings. Sprinkle pizza with garlic powder. Bake 8-10 minutes, until cheese is melted.
