FINANCE REPORT—JOE BOOTH

Reporting for the period ending 9-30-19. We are under budget for the month by \$17,800. We are over budget Year to date by \$45,300. Some of that may be retrieved. The budget is a reasonable guesstimate of what we expect to take in and pay out. But it's not written in stone. Variables present themselves during the year. We stay on top of all delinquencies, and all monies owed are collected in accordance with the law and the statutes. We continue to work on roof replacement and carport repair and replacement. Mission Hills is an older community and we strive to do the best we can to stay on top of keeping the property updated. As I have mentioned before...as association members and owners we own this property and it's our responsibility to keep it up. Assessments are part of living and life in any condo community. We have had them and we have been able to keep them low compared to other communities. Our maintenance team is focused on preventative measures and doing quality work. - The condensation line (PVC) must be secured to the roof scupper/ roof drain.
- A New Thermostat is recommended for the inside the unit.
- No tools or debris shall be left on the roof after completion of install.
- All packaging and construction debris must be removed from the property by the contractor.





The finations of Control The functions of a Compliance Committee as it is written in the Florida State Statute 718 were clearly outlined.

Since you are now armed with that information, this would be a perfect time for you to become a part of something very positive for Mission Hills.

All interested residents are requested to write their name and phone number on a slip of paper, place it in a sealed envelope and label it "Compliance", ATTN: Kay Hunt. Drop it in the office mail slot and you will be notified of an interview date and time.

> Remember: you are not required to be a full-time resident. You must, however, be an owner.

> > You have the laws .. now let's form the order!

COMPLIANCE COMMITTEE AND HOW IT FUNCTIONS

Our Management Company, Ameri-tech, tours our community and notes violations of our By-Laws, the Declaration, or the Florida State Statute 718. The results of this initial survey are given directly to the Mission Hills Board of Directors.

So what, then, is the role of the Compliance Committee?

Chapter 718 Florida Statutes (718.303(3)(b), dated July, 2018, states, in part that "A fine or suspension levied by the board of administration may not be imposed unless the board first provides at least 14 days' written notice to the unit owner and, if applicable, any occupant, licensee, or invitee of the unit owner sought to be fined or suspended, and an opportunity for a hearing before a committee of at least three members appointed by the board who are not officers, directors, or employees of the association, or the spouse, parent, child, brother, or sister of an officer, or employee. The role of the committee is limited to determining whether to confirm or reject the fine or suspension levied by the board. If the committee does not approve the proposed fine or suspension by majority vote, the fine or suspension may not be imposed.'

The preceding paragraphs are key to understanding the role of a Compliance Committee. The committee does not search the community for violations, report violations to the board, nor determine what a fine will be. What the committee does do, if requested by the resident(s) is to meet with him, her or them and review the situation and decide whether the fine proposed by the board is fair and reasonable.

Herb Crusted Pork Tenderloin By Paula Deen (a Facebook Recipe submitted by Helen J. Strupczewski)

Servings: 10

Ingredients

- · I (4 lb) with fat left on boneless pork loin
- · I tablespoon salt
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- · 4 cloves minced garlic
- 1 teaspoon or 2 teaspoons minced fresh thyme leaves dried thyme
- 1 teaspoon or 2 teaspoons fresh basil leaves dried basil
- I teaspoon or 2 teaspoons minced fresh rosemary dried rosemary



Prcheat oven to 475 °F.

Place the pork loin on a rack in a roasting pan. Combine the remaining ingredients in a small bowl. With your fingers, massage the mixture onto the pork loin, covering all of the meat and fat.

Roast the pork for 30 minutes, and then reduce the heat to 425 °F and roast for an additional hour. Test for doneness using an instant-read thermometer. When the internal temperature reaches 155 °F, remove the roast from the oven. Allow it to sit for about 20 minutes before carving. It will continue to cook while it rests.






