Mission Hills Diamond in the Rough

Greetings!

I'd like to start this post by saying how grateful I am for my hard-working team and how fortunate Mission Hills is to have this group of dedicated essential workers as we all continue to navigate our way through 2020.

Last month we included a picture of the team in the newsletter. So everyone is aware, we have 4 part-timers, who start at 10 hours per week, and 6 full-timers. The last few weeks full-time status has been reduced to 4 team members. To put that into perspective, these men are responsible for the care and upkeep of 65 acres of property, which includes 477 units and approximately 1,000 people.

Quite a number of trees were taken down by the storm, and the fall trimming of the Palm trees and power washing of the sidewalks has been completed. We will begin to address the wood replacement work orders. We are now close to 55, but we have done over 176 this year alone.

We will start addressing the vegetation on the mansards and walk ways covering the shingles that is causing mold behind them.


We will also continue to replace our roofs and carport roofs. By the end of this year, we will have completed 14 more carports and 10 more roofs.

Keep in mind...our roofs are being installed with the proper care and maintenance, so they will be the last roofs we have to put on. We will be able to put a layer over the existing roof when needed, and that will take us to the end of our land lease in 50 years. Also keep in mind our carports will require very little maintenance on them once they are replaced. We are also getting warranty work done on our older roofs.
