Reporting for the period ending 11-30-19, we are over budget by \$77,000. As reported in the past this is due to unplanned unforeseen expenses not budgeted for by the Board. Not all but some of it may be recovered in 2020. A budget is just a blueprint and a concerted estimate of how we will spend the monies allotted to us from our revenue sources. It's important that we utilize everything available to us when planning for the next year. The management company and educated Board members who have had experience in budgeting and management. 2020 will be another challenging year. Finishing the roofs and carports are a priority. Planning for anticipated events need to be looked addressed. Working with the maintenance director and Ameritech are essential for positive outcomes. 



The package of information regarding the complete details Sonforming to a regarding COMPLIANCE had been published in the goal that organis April, 2019 issue of our Mission Hills Post (repeated below).

The functions of C.

The functions of a Compliance Committee as it is written in the Florida State Statute 718 were clearly outlined.

Since you are now armed with that information, this would be a perfect time for you to become a part of something very positive for Mission Hills.

All interested residents are requested to write their name and phone number on a slip of paper, place it in a sealed envelope and label it "Compliance", ATTN: Kay Hunt. Drop it in the office mail slot and you will be notified of an interview date and time.

> Remember: you are not required to be a full-time resident. You must, however, be an owner,

> > You have the laws .. now let's form the order!

COMPLIANCE COMMITTEE AND HOW IT FUNCTIONS

Our Management Company, Ameri-tech, tours our community and notes violations of our By-Laws, the Declaration, or the Florida State Statute 718. The results of this initial survey are given directly to the Mission Hills Board of Directors.

So what, then, is the role of the Compliance Committee?

Chapter 718 Florida Statutes (718.303(3)(b), dated July, 2018, states, in part that "A fine or suspension levied by the board of administration may not be imposed unless the board first provides at least 14 days; written notice to the unit owner and, if applicable, any occupant, licensec, or invitee of the unit owner sought to be fined or suspended, and an opportunity for a hearing before a committee of at least three members appointed by the board who are not officers, directors, or employees of the association, or the spouse, parent, child, brother, or sister of an officer, or employee. The role of the committee is limited to determining whether to confirm or reject the fine or suspension levied by the board. If the committee does not approve the proposed fine or suspension by majority vote, the fine or suspension may not be imposed."

The preceding paragraphs are key to understanding the role of a Compliance Committee. The committee does not search the community for violations, report violations to the board, nor determine what a fine will be. What the committee does do, if requested by the resident(s) is to meet with him, her or them and review the situation and decide whether the fine proposed by the board is fair and reasonable.

Anyone wishing to apply for this spot should send a resume or letter to the Board outlining your background and your request to be considered. The ideal candidate should have a background in common sense, budgeting and management. All requests will be considered.



HAM AND CHEESE PARTY ROLLS

(a FB recipe submitted by Helen J. Strupczewski)

Are you invited to a Super Bowl party and don't know what to bring?
You be scoring big with this one!
Happy Super Bowl Sunday ... and may the best team win!

Ingredients

1 can Pillsbury refrigerated Classic Pizza Crust 3/4 lb deli ham (thinly sliced, but not shaved) 12 slices Swiss cheese (thinly sliced) Glaze

1/2 cup (8 tablespoons) butter

2 tablespoons brown sugar

- 1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce
- 1 tablespoon Dijon mustard
- 1 tablespoon poppy seeds (optional)



Instructions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. Coat a 9×13-inch baking dish with cooking spray.
- 2. Unroll the pizza dough onto a cutting board and press into approximately a 13×18-inch rectangle. Top

with ham and cheese slices. Starting on the longer side of the rectangle, roll up the edge tightly. When you reach the end, pinch the seam together and flip the roll so that the seam is face down. Cut into 12 slices, approximately 1-inch wide. Arrange in prepared baking dish.

- 3. Next combine the butter, brown sugar, Worcestershire sauce, mustard, and poppy seeds in a sauce pan over medium heat. Whisk until the butter is melted and the glaze is smooth and combined. Pour evenly over the rolls.
- 4. Cover and refrigerate for up to 24 hours or bake, uncovered for 25 minutes until golden and browned. Enjoy!
