Greetings!

- Please be on the lookout for strange cars in our community. I recently caught a young woman abandoning a dog near the Clubhouse. The dog was turned over to the animal shelter and is safe.
- We have begun our Fall leaf cleanup.
- We've started replacing wood on the front and back of the units. We will not be installing the bottom board back once replaced by hardy board or if the bottom board is the only piece that is rotted and plywood is okay.
- When installing new windows, please make sure you check the window seal all the way around for cracks or gaps, as gaps leave it open to water and insects.
- Please do not plant any trees or bushes in the common area of the court yards.
- In the front and back of your unit, please do not put mulch above the bottom of the siding, and keep 12 inches away from the siding when planting.
- We still have residents throwing sanitary wipes down the sewer line. This needs to stop immediately.
- We also have residents throwing garbage in the recycle containers. Please don't do this!
- We have started the process of Phase IV hot water line replacement; the trees and stumps have been removed.
- When completing a work order, please make sure there is contact information. Also, when writing wood work orders, please make sure to include whether it's the front, the back, or both.
- Reminder...when weeding your areas or raking leaves, please make sure you put the bags alongside the garbage cans and not on the street.
- Please do not drop stuff where the books are in front of our Clubhouse or near the pool area. Throw these items in the garbage.



LAW OF THE LAND

NOTE: Please be careful to read this Policy and Procedure carefully. Remember...empty cigarette packs, cigarette butts, and garbage do NOT constitute "recycled materials." You don't want to get hit in the wallet with a violation, right? Just do the right thing...it's that simple!

MISSION HILLS CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION TRASH AND RECYCLING POLICIES

Receptacles are usually located in your carport area or on the other side of the three-pack or breezeway immediately adjacent to your carport.

TRASH

- Large green cans are for household trash and garbage. Secure the latch and report broken latches by filling out a work order in the Clubhouse lobby. Items such as curtain rods and mop handles are to be bagged or bundled and set beside the trash containers.
- Syringes must not be placed in the trash. They are hazardous waste and your doctor, or the county health department, can assist with their disposal.

RECYCLING

- Everything must be empty, dry and unbagged.
- Nothing smaller than your hand should be placed in the recycling bins.
- If you only have three yellow recycle bins, glass and cans go into the same bin.
- Bags of shredded paper may be placed next to the recycling bins.
- Allowable items for recycling are listed below. All items must be clean:
 - Metal only food and drink cans
 - Glass only bottles and jars
 - Plastic only bottles and jugs
 - Paper and cardboard no food contact, no shredded paper
 - Cartons such as milk and drink cartons no straws
- Heavy cardboard cartons should be folded down and placed next to the bins.

OTHER SUGGESTIONS

- Plastic shopping bags and Styrofoam containers may be taken to various area stores.
- Electronic items can be dropped off at Clearwater collection site on N Hercules on the last Wednesday of each month.
- It is your responsibility to have household furnishings and remodeling debris removed from the property; do not drop them off by the compactor or in trash containers.
- Put items out from Monday morning to Friday.

BROWN SUGAR MUSTARD BAKED HAME

COOK TIME: 2 Hours

INGREDIENTS:

1 10 lb. Spiral Cut Ham

3/4 cup Brown Sugar

2 tbsp. Whole Grain Mustard

1 tbsp. Dijon Mustard

1 can Coca Cola

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Preheat oven to 325 degrees.
- 2. Place ham in a roasting pan cut side down; trim any excess fat.
- 3. In a small bowl, mix brown sugar and mustards; gently pat mixture over ham.
- 4. Pour cola in bottom of pan; cover ham with aluminum foil, sealing around edges of roasting pan.
- 5. Place in oven and cook for 1 hour and 30 minutes.
- 6. Remove aluminum foil from ham and baste ham with juices; place back in oven for 15 minutes.
- 7. Baste ham a second time and continue to cook for 15 minutes more.
- 8. Remove ham from oven and let rest for 15 minutes.
- 9. Slice ham from bone and place on serving platter. Spoon over additional drippings as desired. Store remaining slices of ham in airtight container in refrigerator.


