
A long time ago a great adventure took place.

Here's a treat from the former chef for the Royal Family, Carolyn Robb. She created this dish originally for the Coronation of Queen Elizabeth II. Now you, too, can enjoy serving this dish that is fit for a Queen!

#### **INGREDIENTS:**

2 tbsp. Honey

1 tbsp. Curry Powder

2 tbsp. White Wine

3 tbsp. Mango Chutney

½ cup + 2 tbsp. Mayonnaise

5 tbsp. Heavy Cream (whipped) or Greek Yogurt

4 cooked Chicken Breasts, chopped


1 tbsp. Mango, dried and finely diced

1/₃ cup Cashews, lightly toasted

1 ripe Peach, peeled and thinly sliced

#### INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. In a small saucepan, cook honey and curry powder for 2 minutes, stirring constantly.






